CHURCH NOTICE

Parking Advisory from LTA

We have received an LTA advisory regarding indiscriminate parking along Dunbar Walk, Coldstream Avenue and East Coast Road. This poses potential hazards to pedestrians and other road users.

There shall be strictly No Parking:

- a. At road bends, entrances or exits of any access;
- b. Within 3 metres of a fire hydrant, 6 metres of a road junction;
- c. Parking abreast to another vehicle, footway; and/or
- At locations with enforcement markings such as double yellow lines and continuous white lines.
- e. Vehicles must also be parked parallel to the road kerb and in the direction of the traffic flow.

LTA will take enforcement actions against vehicles found parking indiscriminately. Please park your vehicles at the designated parking places for the safety of all road users. Thank you for your cooperation.

Trial Parking Project: Park & Ride

To reduce indiscriminate parking around CMC, we will be organizing a trial Park & Ride project from 23 March - 25 May 2025, where drivers are encouraged to park at the car park at **Block 16A Marine Terrace**. A 23-seater bus will shuttle between the car park and CMC on Sundays before and after service.
